14 ineligibility determination. The department shall promulgate  
15 regulations and issue statements of policy establishing a formal  
16 appeals process.

17 (d) Emergency situations.--The department shall promulgate  
18 regulations and issue statements of policy regarding emergency  
19 situations, where an immediate change in settings is needed for  
20 a participant to address an imminent threat or health or safety  
21 issue.
